

29 July 1942: Japanese retake Kokoda 30 July 1916: HMAS Pioneer bombards Dar Es Salaam, Tanganyika (now Tanzania) 31 July 1962: AATTV arrives in South Việt Nam 2 August 1950: RAAF 77 Sqn completes 800 sorties in Korea 4 August 1900: About 3000 Boers attack Elands River Post, mostly manned by Australians, killing most of 1500 horses, mules and oxen. Four Australians were killed in the subsequent siege 5 August 1914: German ship SS Pfalz captured in Port Phillip Bay, the first enemy vessel seized in Australian waters

Famous War Correspondent

Sir William Howard Russell, CVO (1827–1907) was a reporter with *The Times*, and is considered to have been one of the first modern war correspondents. He spent 22 months covering the Crimean War. He later covered events during the Indian Rebellion

of 1857, the American Civil War, the Austro-Prussian War, and the Franco-Prussian War. His dispatches from Crimea to *The Times* are regarded as the world's first war correspondence.

This book in our collection was dedicated to him by John Arthur Bayley (1831-1903) was a British Army infantry officer. It is a personal account of his time as an officer on campaign in India. It came from Warren Perry's collection.
