The US Guide to New Guinea and the Solomon Islands



This 1943 pocket-sized guide for Americans was introduced by:

"On this job some of the hardest fighting over some of the worst terrain in the world is going on. We don't need to tell you about that, nor is a long lecture needed to prove that New Guinea and the Solomon Islands are of the greatest strategic importance to the United Nations."

"Everyone remembers only too well the grim days when the Japs spread out like a

swarm of locusts over the peaceful Philippines and East Indies toward Australia, and eastward into the Pacific Islands. Determined Australian jungle fighters slowed and finally stopped them in the New Guinea mountains. Meanwhile our naval task forces hit at them in the seas of east New Guinea and the Solomons, and our marines gave them the surprise of their lives at Tulagi and Guadalcanal. Australia was saved from almost certain invasion, and protection of our vital supply lines to the South Pacific was assured."
